Executive Board Meeting Minutes May 30, 2023

Call to Order

Moderator Leah Horn called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Spiritual Reflection

Leah read a message from the UCC daily Devotional, and offered a prayer.

Open Forum

No one was present for this item.

Consent Agenda

The Consent Agenda was accepted.

Action and Discussion Items

LanSINGout Chorus

The group is not available on the last Sunday in June. We'll try another date. We still need music for that date.

Emergency Procedures Plan

The Emergency Leadership Response Team will be Gary Burt, Gary Cypher and one other. A few minor word changes were recommended. It was moved by Karen, seconded by Kim to approve the Plan. Motion passed.

Endowment Committee

Fay explained there was an error on the Endowment Committee Annual Report, explained the error and the proposed correction. The available amounts in each category were discussed. Julie Wilkinson has agreed to join the Committee. It was moved by Bil, seconded by Fay to approve Julie's addition to the Committee. Motion passed.

<u>Kitchen Repair/Upgrade</u>

Leah reported that Gary Burt has done extensive work on securing bids to replace the dishwasher and upgrade the water heating ability. The total cost will be about \$17,000. Possible sources of that amount were discussed. Item tabled.

Sabbatical in 2024

Bil supplied a summary of how pastoral duties were handled during Pastor Nicolette's 2013 sabbatical. Karen suggested a small group be formed to start the planning for Pastor Laura's sab-



batical. She volunteered to be a part of this group, as did Leah and Lynn.

Misc. Updates

Personnel Committee. One more member is still needed.

- Lugnuts Outing. Charlene informed the Board that we have enough signed up to qualify for a discount on ticket prices.
- Staff Substitute List. It was agreed that it would be acceptable to go forward without a formal named substitute for the Custodian.

Update on Bells Purchase. Leah announced that the \$6000 goal has been met.

CPR/First Aid Training. The training will take place at 1 PM on June 14th at the local Fire Barn.

Summer Music Scheduling. Kelly reported that two individuals have signed up an each will help twice. More are needed.

New Business

Ministries of the Church Group

Leah explained that the group that had been studying church functions and who should be performing them has not met for some time but will be reconvening soon. They had previously produced several drafts of an overall look at distribution of church duties.

Digital Ministries from "Convergence"

Pastor Laura informed the Board of the website "Convergence" that is offering many online class opportunities related to church topics. Topics include; Church Justice, Visioning, Church Growth, How to Lead, and many others. There is a charge of \$149 to take the classes. This is the website that had previously been "Center for Progressive Renewal".

Youth Activity Sundays.

Kelly explained that she and others are youth focused events for this summer. There will be one each month and they will be open to all, not just church members.
