#### First Congregational United Church of Christ – Grand Ledge Executive Board Meeting Minutes April 25, 2023

#### Call to Order

Moderator Leah Horn called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Board Members present: Charlene Avery, Gary Cypher, Kim Dible-Glasser, Ron Erskine, Lynn Hart, Karen Holcomb-Merrill, Leah Horn, Pastor Laura, Fay Schroeder, Kelly Stuible-Clark and Bil Turner

#### **Spiritual Reflection**

Leah read a passage from the book of Revelations, a quote from Dag Hammarskjold, offered her thoughts and a prayer.

#### **Open Forum**

No one was present for this item.

#### **Consent Agenda**

Pastor Laura spoke to the highlights of her monthly report. The Consent Agenda was accepted.

#### **Action and Discussion Items**

#### Sabbatical (added item)

Pastor Laura reminded the Board of her eligibility for a three month sabbatical beginning next summer. There was discussion about when that might best fit into the Church year. It was moved by Ron seconded by Karen to allow the sabbatical to run from June 1 to August 31. Motion passed. The Board is asked to contemplate how best to cover Pastoral Care. Bil will look at how all the pastoral duties were organized during Pastor Nicolette's sabbatical.

#### Possible Red Cross CPR training

Ron will poll the congregation about the best possible June date for this training.

#### E-mail votes

Hand bell and chimes purchase. The vote was yes, to purchase the hand bells and chimes. So far, \$1150 has been donated, plus an equal matching pledge toward this purchase. Memorial funds are also available, per Lynn. A special offering will be announced at a worship service.

#### Position Descriptions

The PDs for Choir Director and the Organist/Accompanist positions plus an addendum to Choir Director PD were sent to the Board by e-mail. The Board discussed the PDs. It was moved by Karen, seconded by Gary to approve all three documents. Motion passed.

#### Summer Music Scheduling

Kin and Pastor Laura have been working on aspects of this item. Kelly will create a list of potential participants.

#### LanSINGout Chorus (added item)

This group may be available on the last Sunday in June, which is Pride weekend. They probably have a fee in the \$300 area. ONA has some restricted funds. Leah will inquire about the fee and about using the ONA funds.

#### <u>Video person for funerals</u> (added item)

A funeral may need a substitute video person. It was moved by Karen, seconded by Charlene to pay the substitute at the same rate as the regular individual. Motion passed.

#### Purchase of laminator

Two different options for a laminator were discussed. The more economical one appears to be about \$50. It was moved by Lynn, seconded by Ron to purchase the more economical one. Motion passed.

#### Misc. Updates

- Emergency Procedures. A comprehensive document has been produced by Mary Lou Prevost. The Board will review and be prepared to offer comments next month.
- Personnel Committee. Currently the Personnel Committee consists of Karen Holcomb Merrill, Marsha Kent and Lisa Reed. A replacement is being sought for Lisa Reed. The Committee will be working on the remaining Position Descriptions and participating in annual staff evaluations.
- Potential Lugnuts outing. Charlene has it scheduled for August 19th. Announcements will be made.
- Staff substitute list. Substitutes are available for all but the custodians. A custodian task list may be available; Pastor Laura will look for it. It may be possible to find substitute custodians on an as-needed basis. It should be noted there may be occasions when there is a need to do some custodial work on Sunday morning before Worship

Bystander Training. Kelly stated that the training has been scheduled for September 5<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM and that it will be the one hour option.

#### **New Business**

• Lynn announced that the Food Bank support effort at Meijer generated a total of \$16490.

Fay told the Board that Demphna has been working 12-16 hours per month, while her agreement calls for 2 hours per week. After discussion, it was moved by Fay, seconded by Ron to increase the hours of that position to 3 hours per week, beginning next program year. Motion passed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM

The next Executive Board Meeting will be Tuesday, May 23rd, 2023 at 6:30 PM.
