First Congregational United Church of Christ – Grand Ledge **Executive Board Meeting Minutes** December 28, 2021

### Call to Order

Moderator Leah Horn called the meeting to order at 6:32 PM.

This meeting was held over Zoom due to Covid-19 virus distancing recommendations. Some members attended by telephone.

Board Members present: Leah Horn, Lynn Hart, Pastor Laura, Karen Holcomb-Merrill, Fay Schroeder, Chris Clark, Thea Oatman, Kim Dible Glasser and Bil Turner. Kelly Stuible-Clark was also present.

## **Spiritual Reflection**

Pastor Laura spoke of a recent daily devotional titled "Don't Stop Now" that had focused on Psalm 148. We may think about a post-Christmas slow down, but the Psalmist seems to advise us to not slow down. Praise of God is every day, every year. Sing God's praises! A prayer followed.

**<u>Open Forum</u>** Kelly Stuible-Clark was present to discuss some recent items all related to our social media presence.

Results of our Facebook advertisements that detailed how many and who has been watching our Worship Services. We can broaden our reach if we each "like, share and comment" on the Worship Service posts.

Kelly posts on Instagram about our church, usually once a week and normally midweek.

Discussed the pros and cons of streaming on Facebook, YouTube and both simultaneously. Simultaneous streaming may present some challenges, but they can be overcome. StreamYard will charge \$25/month to stream with both. (See Action Item below)

**Consent Agenda** The Consent Agenda was accepted.

Action and Discussion Items

<u>Streaming Service trial</u> Regarding the StreamYard discussion in Open Forum, moved by Karen, seconded by Chris, to purchase a two month trial of the "Basic Plan" that would allow us to stream simultaneously. Motion passed.

#### Personnel Update-Video Tech Position.

The Personnel Committee has interviewed and hired an individual, David Wee, for the Video Tech position. He will be able to start soon.

The roofer still can't get enough staff together to attend to our problem. There is no new info on the boiler. There is a light out between the two north entry doors and a parking lot light out in the driveway.

### Stewardship Campaign.

The total of pledges received to date is \$119.3K and not much more is expected. With the proposed expense budget, that will mean about a \$21K deficit.

### Proposed Budget

After discussion, moved by Bil, seconded by Fay to approve the proposed budget of \$152K. Motion passed.

#### Board and Committee duties.

Fay has been unable to locate a notebook with Board and Committee duty descriptions. We will need to start this description process over. Also, Kelly has asked that a job description be prepared for the Social Media Administrator.

<u>Change in Annual Meeting date</u>. After discussion, moved by Bil, seconded by Fay to move the Annual Meeting to January 30<sup>th</sup>. Motion passed. This change will need to be announced during the Worship Service on the two preceding Sundays.

<u>Courage Grant ideas.</u> There have been many thoughtful emails exchanged about possible uses of this Grant. After discussion, moved by Lynn to use half the Grant to encourage the Hayes School staff in the face of the Pandemic, and half to help defray costs of replacing the Sanctuary fans. Motion passed. Lynn will respond to the Michigan Conference Office with our decision on how to use the Grant.

<u>Gas Cards in the Office</u> The discussion focused on who can give out the existing gas cards when an emergency need is evident. There are many unanswered questions here. Leah will gather information.

Meeting adjourned at 8:48 PM
